## Chairman's Report

The situation regarding Brexit continues to hot up with the Government now saying that it will serve the Article 50 notice after March 2017. This has immediately caused the pound to descend to a level not seen for over 3 decades with the pound / euro being at 1.13. This, of course, means that Brexit would not be completed until after March 2019. This has at least 2 serious consequences, the first being that, as the financial markets hate uncertainty, the pound may continue to suffer and the stock market may be more volatile. The second is the question as to how the Government could possibly hope to negotiate satisfactory exit terms if it has already served the Article 50 notice. Who of us would sign a contract to buy a car and then negotiate the price afterwards! I referred last month to Nissan possibly leaving the U.K. and the head of that company has since said that that may happen in the event of tariffs being imposed.

Those of us that are firmly entrenched in France should think about making a further commitment to France by obtaining the Carte de Séjour Permanent, the forms for which can be obtained through the following website - <https://www.service-public.fr/particuliers/vosdroits/F22116>. Other alternatives open to us are; identifying long lost grandparents born in Ireland or other EU countries in order to obtain citizenship / a passport of that country or seeking citizenship of France if you comply with the requirements.

## Expats may open UK bank accounts

People living in France are now free to open a new bank account with a bank in the UK even if they have no address there, thanks to a new banking regulation that came into force recently.



The EU Payment Accounts Directive was passed two years ago, including a 'right of access' to a payment account and a non-discrimination clause. It has now been made operational in the UK with the coming into force of the Payment Account Regulations 2015.

Not only can you not be refused a payment account on the basis of residency but the new legislation also means that you do not even need a fixed address. A bank has 10 working days to open or refuse an account but a refusal must be explained and the grounds for doing so are narrowly confined to areas such as money laundering and links to other criminal acts. Any refusal should also come with explanations as to the customer's next steps, including their right to appeal to the Financial Ombudsman Service. However it remains to be seen if all the UK banks will comply.

## Radio stations in English

A new internet radio station launched recently is targeting the estimated 200,000 British expats in France with a mixture of chat and music delivered entirely in English. Expat Radio, is internet based at [www.ex-patradio.fr](http://www.ex-patradio.fr) in order to avoid French radio regulations, which dictate that FM and digital stations there must offer French language content.



Dave Hailwood, 47, a former radio DJ from Manchester, is the director of Expat Radio, which he hopes will help unite the English-speaking community in France and stave off loneliness. "People tune in to their favourite radio stations from the UK online, largely because of the banter and interaction they enjoy. I'm hoping to bring something new to the market – live discussion on everything from sport to property as well as up to date music - but make it relevant to expats in France and their unique situation," said Mr Hailwood, who has lived in La Vendee, western France, for 11 years. "We're hoping to bring some humour to expats, with the focus firmly on living and enjoying the expat life. I'm hoping to involve listeners as much as possible. In this way, we're hoping to create a real feeling of community between expats." Expat Radio aims to cross the generational divide with eclectic music from Motown and golden oldies to hip-hop and dance. There will also be guests discussing the issues of the day, with listeners encouraged to call and email in with their views.

It is not the only English-language radio available in France. Riviera Radio, based in Monaco, is available on 106.5FM to Anglophones living in the south of France. The station, launched more than 30 years ago, attracts around 200,000 listeners, and is also available worldwide through its website [rivieraradio.mc](http://rivieraradio.mc). According to Paul Kavanagh, managing director of the station, "we play songs you know and love from the Eighties

to today mixed with BBC News as well as local news and information, updated every hour."

Meanwhile Peter Richards, media director of internet site Expats Radio ([expatsradio.com](http://expatsradio.com)), said: "Our programmes contain everything from cookery to light political discussion. We have editors worldwide who provide content, and listeners can tune in to the programmes that interest them, whenever they want."

However, although listening to English language radio can be a great way to connect with other English speakers, those wishing to acquire more than basic French should also try to tune in to stations in that language. Listening to local radio gives people an opportunity to train their ear to local accents, and develop a better understanding of vocabulary, colloquial phrases and grammatical structures. This leads to better communication skills and increased confidence when talking with native speakers.

## Singers campaign to defend quotas



More than 1,800 figures from the French music industry have signed a petition in defence of the quota system for French-language songs played on the radio. Top French music artists including Jean-Jacques Goldman, Charles Aznavour, Benjamin Biolay and Nolwenn Leroy are among the signatories, who include songwriters, composers and publishers - as well as the cartoonist Plantu.

The campaign was organised by the French performing rights body Sacem and comes as a parliamentary committee starts discussing possible changes to the quota law. At present, at least 40% of the songs broadcast on French radio must be in French - although a slightly reduced quota of 35% applies to stations that are committed to championing emerging new talent. A recent report found that some stations were only fulfilling their quota requirements by playing a handful of songs on repeat. The number of albums released in French has dropped 66% between 2003 and 2014, according to figures released by the record labels. With big-selling artists such as Daft Punk, David Guetta and Charlotte Gainsbourg choosing to sing in English to appeal to a wider audience, 83% of French music production is no longer in French.



## Cafés

Some facts you may not know:



- Unless a café has a sign outside to the contrary, you can order a drink and eat food bought elsewhere.
- Cafés must show identical prices inside and outside, and fixed price menus must say whether drinks are included. The bill must detail every item ordered and not just the total.
- Once you have ordered a drink there is no limit to the time you can sit at a table. If customers are waiting, staff may ask you to make way and, while it is not strictly legal, it is good manners to agree.
- An espresso has less caffeine than a filter coffee as the coffee is in contact with the water for longer in the filter. Make coffee with water between 90-96°C. Boiling water extracts bitter flavours.
- Café owners can be fined €45,000 if they refuse customers with a baby or pushchair.
- When ordering in a café, don't forget the essential pleasantries: Bonjour, s'il vous plaît and merci. It has been known to see the following sign in a café: Un café €1,50; Un café s'il vous plaît €1,30; Bonjour, un café s'il vous plaît €1,00.

## "PROOF OF LIFE" FORM FOR UK PENSIONERS

If you are in receipt of a UK State Pension, you may have received a letter concerning Life Certificate, and a PROOF OF LIFE FORM. These are sent out randomly and have to be filled out and co-signed by a semi-official signatory, then returned to the Newcastle Dept of Works & Pensions in 8 weeks (soon to be changed to 16), otherwise the pension could be cut off.



The form can be signed by any of the following:

Bank/building Society official or accountant  
Barrister/Solicitor or manager of Oaths!  
Doctor, Dentist, physiotherapist or pharmacist  
Government official or local Mayor  
The equivalent of a Magistrate, Justice of the Peace, or member of the local police force  
Minister of Religion  
Care home/nursing home manager

## Speed fines for Brits

Over 43,000 Britons were fined for speeding in France last year, even though they are not covered by cross-border information sharing until May 2017, because the hire car companies pass on driver details to the agency that deals with traffic violations. They also add a fee for dealing with the complaint, which is usually about 30€. The automatic fines average 100€.
