



Journées européennes du patrimoine



Founded in 1984 by the Ministry of Culture, the Open Day for historical monuments was held on the third Sunday of September and was an immediate success with the public. The following year many European countries followed France and set up a similar event at the same time of year. At the second Conference of European Ministers of Culture organized by the Council of Europe in Granada, Jack Lang, then Minister of Culture proposed that the French model should be expanded throughout Europe. In 1991, the Council of Europe officially founded the European Heritage Days and the event has been a great success across Europe, with 50 countries currently taking part.

In France, the *Journées européennes du patrimoine* now take place over two days on the third weekend in September – this year the 14th and 15th. Combining public and private initiatives, they offer the opportunity to publicize the work of government in collaboration with local authorities and public and private landowners, and present the work of those who are involved in the preservation and enhancement of heritage.

These days are a perfect time to visit the French national heritage - monuments, churches, theatres, castles - but also private houses, banks, courts, prefectures, city halls, chambers of commerce etc., all kinds of buildings that are usually closed to the public. Local events are too numerous to mention so check with your local Tourist Office or Mairie who will have all the details. You can also check the website: <http://www.journeesdupatrimoine.culture.fr/> where a full programme is listed.

However, there is a special event taking place in St Raphaël which may be of interest to our readers. On Wednesday 19 September at 14h30 there will be an illustrated talk in French entitled "La Présence Britannique à Saint-Raphaël: 1880-1930" about the arrival of the British in Saint Raphaël and the effects they had on the town, some of which can still be seen today (eg. the old Valescure golf course, St John's Anglican church, etc). This talk will be given by Lindsay Benoist, who is from a French/British family, and who is an expert on this subject. It will take place at the Médiathèque, Place Gabriel Péri, St Raphaël – in the new Centre Culturel.

Trip to Les Baux De Provence

Last year a number of members took a day out to visit the unusual and spectacular Carrières de Lumières at Les Baux de Provence (15km north of Arles) where there was an exhibition of the art of Van Gogh and Gauguin projected onto the walls of this former quarry. This year there is another exhibition running until 5 January 2014 featuring the art of Monet, Chagall and Renoir.

It is therefore proposed to make another visit, again using car sharing where possible, on Saturday 5 October. The intention is for the cars to arrive at the opening at 10.00 (a limited amount of parking is available directly opposite) and then to view the exhibition, followed by lunch in the village. We will book a restaurant but meals will be chosen and paid for individually. The cost of entry is 9.50€ per head and if there is a group booking then the full rate is 7.50€. Alternatively if members wish to have entry to the chateau as well – a ruined castle overlooking the village with fantastic views - then there is a combined ticket at 14.50€. The address of Carrières de Lumières is Route de Maillane (about 500 metres outside of the village), 13520 Les Baux de Provence.

If you wish to visit this fascinating exhibition please complete the booking form and state if you wish the combined ticket. We will then assess if it is possible to purchase the group tickets and refund monies if appropriate.

Chairman's Report

Continuing from my comments of last month, we, as a Committee, are endeavouring to remain true to the roots of the BAV in providing welfare and charitable support both to members and British people in the Var. As a member it is very easy to be unaware of the charitable and welfare support that we offer and the reason for the establishment of the BA. Clearly the visible activity of the BAV is the social side but this enables the welfare aspect to flourish.

The BA was established many years ago by a few individuals due to the lack of British and French government support for the increasingly sizeable British community in the south east of France. Whilst times have changed, the hardship continues for many in our area and, even where long term government support may be available, short term support may be needed. We maintain strict confidentiality in our assistance to individuals and families and therefore it is impossible to publicise or give details of this support, hence the lack of reference to this in the newsletter and the lack of common knowledge of this work.

Ann, our Welfare coordinator, is always at the end of the telephone or contactable by email to those needing assistance which ranges from the need for financial assistance, due to unemployment, illness and many other circumstances, to general enquiries as to who to contact in a variety of instances and advice on availability of pensions and medical cover.

So, please rest assured that we continue to be an active charity and in order to support this financially we need to raise funds through our social functions, the book exchange, and Christmas Cards. Please note that the Christmas cards will be available at social functions and Neighbourhood Network meetings from early September.

This neatly leads on to the welfare aspect of the BAV and, in this respect, we feel that the need to speak at least some basic French is important particularly in dealing with the many government departments, hospitals, doctors and other consultants. We would like to improve members' linguistic skills by supporting French lessons, possibly through the Neighbourhood Network groups, so please see the reference to this in the article in this newsletter.

British Satellite TV - Update

As mentioned in the BAV Newsletter earlier this year, some UK Satellite TV channels had been transferred to the new Astra2F satellite which has a weaker signal here in the south of France. To date the channel 5 range of channels, channel 4 HD and 4Seven plus some ITV regions have moved, so you may be experiencing poor reception on these especially during the evening or in bad weather.

The next new satellite Astra2E, which MAY take the rest of the UK satellite TV channels, was expected to be launched in May this year but due to the failure of another satellite launch it seems the Astra2E launch has been put back. (Oh dear!) The general internet consensus is that Astra2E will now launch in September with a service date sometime in November this year – just in time for Christmas!

No one has officially stated that any TV channels will actually be moved to the new satellite, so this is just a best "guesstimate" as Astra2E seems to be the same type as Astra2F. Thus the advice is to wait until if and when any changes happen and see if they affect you before buying a bigger dish
